Paul Greenwood is the Deputy District Attorney with the San Diego County District Attorney's Office. Mr. Greenwood has been a lawyer for more than 25 years. He is qualified to practice in both California and in the UK. He had 13 years experience as a criminal lawyer in England before moving to California.

In January 1996, he created and continues to head the Elder Abuse Prosecution Division.

He has completed seven murder trials and been involved in the prosecution of over 400 felony cases of elder and dependent adult abuse, both physical and financial. He assisted in getting the mandated reporter law passed in California whereby all employees of banks and other financial organizations must report suspicious transactions to law enforcement or to social services.

Mr. Greenwood is currently chair of the California District Attorneys Elder Abuse statewide committee and is an elected board member of the National Committee for the Prevention of Elder Abuse. His most recent award was the National Adult Protective Services Special award for leadership in the prosecutorial field for elder victims. He is passionate about pursuing justice for all victims.
