

DuPage County is located in northern Illinois, west of Cook County. According to the US Census Bureau, the 2004 estimated population was 928,718 with a land area of 334 square miles.

The DuPage County Family Center Neutral Exchange Program is located at the DuPage County Family Center in Wheaton. Four programs share the space and the overhead costs of the facility.

The site has two separate entrances with a locked hallway between the two waiting areas. A receptionist is located at each door and a uniformed security officer is present inside the building. The hours for exchanges are Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays from 4:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m., Saturdays from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. and Sundays from 3:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.
