ORDER DIRECTING USE OF NEUTRAL EXCHANGE SERVICES

This matter coming before the court, the court having jurisdiction of the parties and the subject matter hereto, and the court being fully advised in the premises;

THE COURT FINDS that visitation and the children's best interests will be facilitated by the use of Neutral Exchange Services provided by the DuPage County Psychological Services at the DuPage County Family Center;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

A.) Within three (3) business days, each of the parties shall contact the DuPage County Family Center, 1525 N. Main Street, Wheaton, Illinois, 60187; telephone (630) 407-2450; fax (630) 407-2451 to arrange an intake interview for visitation exchanges at the Family Center under the Neutral Exchange program.

B.) Within ten (10) Business days, each of the parties shall appear at the DuPage County Family Center, cooperate with the personnel at the DuPage County Family Center, complete the intake interview and provide truthful information as requested by such personnel.

C.) Visitation shall be pursuant to the visitation summary. Exact time for visitation pick-up and drop-off shall be set by the DuPage County Family Center. The parties are required to use the services of the DuPage County Family Center for all exchanges that can be accommodated by the Center. To the extent that scheduled visitation days cannot be accommodated by the Center such as holidays, visitation pick-up and drop-off locations and times for such days shall remain as previously arranged or ordered.

D.) Each of the parties shall comply with all Rules for Neutral Exchange as established by the DuPage County Family Center.

E.) Violation of this Order or the Rules for Neutral Exchange may result in sanctions for Contempt of Court and termination of Neutral Exchange Services.
